At-risk children who DO NOT receive a high-quality early childhood education are:


- 25% more likely to drop out of school.
- 40% more likely to become a teen parent.
- 50% more likely to be placed in special education.
- ► 60% more likely to never attend college.




Q7 Do you feel the childcare/preschool that is offered in yourcommunity is high quality?



Q9 Do you feel that there are enough childcare/preschool options in your community?



Q13 On a scale of one to five, five being the most important, what priority would you give to high quality childcare availability for the future growth and development of Platte County?


