## CHS grad releases CD Home to Me

In the early nineties if you heard the name Rachel White around Columbus High School, you probably heard "beautiful voice" mentioned simultaneously. Rachel has spent many years using that beautiful voice and has recently released a CD titled "Home to Me."

Sounds like a perfect set up since Rachel Scott has moved back to Columbus with her husband, Greg, and two sons Jayden (4) and Sammy (2). Greg is a pastor at Word of Life Church, and Rachel is home with her children by day and with high school students by night giving private voice lessons.

Last month, the 1994 graduate gave two packed house concerts in Columbus singing songs to debut her CD "Home to Me." Her CD is made up of 11 original, Christian-based songs she wrote.


Even though they might have a common theme, the styles of song vary from folk to country to funky gospel. She described her writing as being both personal and inspirational.

"Some of them came from my personal experiences and some were inspired by other people," Scott said.

Scott first began to write her own music when she was a freshman in college. At that point, she wasn't sure what she was going to do with them. But with the help of her husband, who is also a sound engineer, and some of her musically talented friends, the CD came to be.

"It was definitely a collaborative effort," Scott said about the CD.

Since high school, Rachel studied music at the University of Nebraska at Kearney, where she received her formal training. She has been trained in choral, solo work and theater. While at school she also



studied opera and classical music.

Other musical ventures for Scott include leading worship at two churches, and as a former Miss Columbus and Miss Nebraska, touring to several engagements. Some of those performances were here in Columbus, including most recently the National Day of Prayer event in May.

After living in big cities such as Omaha and Minneapolis, coming home to Columbus has been somewhat of an adjustment. Someone who has helped out with that adjustment is Columbus High School music instructor Fred Ritter.

"Just like in high school, Fred has continued to support me," she said. "I feel he's got my back. Now that I am working with high school students, I see he continues to inspire students. He believes in every one of them.

"I am grateful for the opportunities CHS had to offer, and I'm glad I took advantage of those opportunities," Scott said. "Columbus High has a lot of things going on that kids can get involved in, and I am grateful to have had those experiences."

Playing for the state championship in volleyball was the highlight in an up and down fall sports season for the Discoverers.

The volleyball team finished the season with a 38-3 record. They won the Bellevue Invite, Millard North Invite, Omaha Westside Invite, Columbus Invite and the Greater Nebraska Athletic Conference titles.

They lost the state championship match to 10-time state title winner Bellevue West in a very hard fought match. They defeated Bellevue West earlier in the season to claim the Bellevue Invite title.

University of Nebraska recruit Amanda Gates, Amanda Iwansky, Amber Kobus, Morgan Pillen, Heidi Zoucha, Brook Rambour and Kristen Micek led the team.

The marquee fund committee is selling bricks for \$100 a piece. If you would like to help a little more, a \$1,000 donation will get your name or business engraved on a larger brick.



By purchasing a brick, you can become a part of the history of Columbus High School. Reunion classes, what better way to make sure your class is not forgotten and help out your alma mater.




