Several advanced to state Fall sports teams wrap up season

The fall sports teams wrapped up their season, and the teams put forth a tremendous effort that makes us proud to be CPS Alumni.

The varsity volleyball team finished the season 23-11. They were 1-1 at Districts and qualified for State as a wildcard. They lost in the first round of State to North Platte. The junior varsity ended the season 8-6, sophomore team 9-2, freshmen A team 13-1 and conference champs and freshmen B team 5-3.

The varsity football team finished the year 5-5 and advanced to the first round of the state play-offs where they fell to Millard West. The junior varsity team ended the season 2-4, the sophomore team 4-1 and the freshmen team 2-5. Amber Brandenburger finished eighth at the state cross country meet. The team ended up finishing fifth at state and second at Districts. The girls won the dual with Norfolk, took third at the Albion and Norfolk Invites, first at the Grand Island Invite, second at the Columbus Invite, and first at the GNAC.

The boys cross country team landed sixth at the District competition. They lost the dual with Norfolk, took seventh at the Albion Invite, 11th at the Norfolk Invite, seventh at the Grand Island Invite, sixth at the Columbus Invite and seventh at the GNAC.

Jenny Andrew took second at the district golf competition, and she also qualified for State where she finished with a score of 181. The team finished fifth at Districts. They ended up ninth at the Kearney Invite, eighth at the Grand Island Invite, 11th at the Fremont/Norfolk Invite, 10th at the Lincoln East Invite and fourth at the GNAC tourney. The JV team also took fifth at the Columbus Invite.

The boy's tennis team finished sixth at the state competition. At state, #1 Singles – Jason Lescelius finished 2-1; #2 Singles – Marcus Hansen 2-1; #1 Doubles – Darren Betz/Tyler Fleischacker 1-1; and #2 Doubles – Justin Kuta/Jared Thomas 1-1. The varsity team was 6-2 in duals and the JV team 7-1. The team took fifth at the Fremont Invite, ninth at the Papillion-LaVista Invite and first at GNAC.

The varsity softball team finished 11-26.

Voters pass \$17.68 million CHS bond issue

Columbus High School will get a face-lift thanks to the passage of a \$17.68 million bond issue.

The school bond issue was approved 1,869 to 1,791 in a special election held on Oct. 14. The bond will help make many needed improvements such as replacing the mechanical and electrical systems, updating existing spaces and replacing inefficient windows, doors and equipment.

New construction will include an additional 38, 377 square feet of space. By renovating existing areas and utilizing newly created space, 11 new instructional rooms can be added.

The high school was built in

1956 with additions being made in 1965, 1975 and 1987. The District has put a lot of time and effort into finding out what was the best course of action.

Over the past five years, the District analyzed the high school needs and researched different options. The Board of Education looked at everything from making no improvements to building a new high school, which would cost \$35 million.

Community presentations were made by volunteers to provide background information and solicit input. After the presentations, the volunteers made a recommendation to the board.

The bond issue will raise the levy 13.4 cents per \$100 of evaluation, which would amount to an increase of \$11.17 per month on a \$100,000 home.

Jim Dennell of the architectural firm Ciaccio/Dennell Group has meet with staff and reviewed the plan that was created a year ago.

"We did touch everyone," Dennell said. "As far as a whole plan goes, everyone can live with it."

Dennell said many of the staff's concerns have already been addressed.

Construction is slated to begin in the summer of 2004 and be completed in 2006.
