## Former teacher celebrates 65th wedding anniversary

On July 4, 2009 at the Real Life retirement home in Columbus over 50 people gathered to celebrate the 65<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary of Ralph and Hilda Eickhoff. The event was hosted by their children, Bruce, Ralph Jr., JoAnn, and Larry (CHS classes of '64, '67, '70, and '71, respectively) and their families. #### **Boys Baseball**

The CHS Baseball Team finished the successful season in 2009 with a 22-10 record. Two seniors were honored with All-State awards. Kurt Farmer was chosen as a 1st team All-State infielder and Michael Blatchford was honored as a 2nd team All-State outfielder. Kurt attends UNL. Michael attends Creighton University. The Discoverers were rated ninth at the end of the season by the Omaha World Herald.

#### **Boys Track**

Zack Lindsley, Dean Shurter and Jon Powell qualified for the state track meet for the Discoverers boys team. Lindsley threw to a second place finish in discus and a ninth place finish in the shot put. Shurter threw to a seventh place finish in the discus and Powell finished twelfth in the 3200 meter run. The team finished with 10 points at State.

Lindsley threw the discus for a new school record of 181'4". **Boys Golf** 

State qualifier Jordan Williams led the boys golf team. Williams competed well with a stroke average under 80. The Discoverers were very young in the 2009 season. Two young golfers that competed were Brett Beal and Matt Otten. These two golfers both lettered their freshman season and became team leaders. Jake Gotschall and Dennis Bouc were also first year letter winners. Last season, the team grew as a group and began to learn what it takes to compete at a high level. Both Williams and Beal were Academic All-State selections.

#### Boys Soccer

The boys soccer had a lot of success as a team as well as some individual accomplishments. The team set a school record for the most wins in a season with 14. They also tied a state record with shutouts in a season with 13 out of 19 games played. This was the first time a CHS boys soccer team reached the finals and finished as runner up. Individually, Tony Olvera and Michael Ziola received first team all-state recognition. Olvera and Ziola along with seniors Andy Christenson, Parker Staroscik and Junior Cody Fleischacker helped anchor a defense that allowed 4 goals in 19 games.

#### **Girls Soccer**

In 2009, the girls soccer team finished the season at 9-6 narrowly missing a state wildcard birth by .5 of a point. The girls finished the year strong defeating 5th ranked Elkhorn 2-0 and 10<sup>th</sup> ranked North Platte on the road 3-2. The season ended with a heartbreaking loss to Scotus 1-2 in the district semi-final. Leading the way in saves was Shelby Hughes with 51. The Discoverers featured a balanced team attack and had 9 girls finish with double-digit points. For the season, the Discoverers outscored the opposition 51-24. Danielle Archuleta, Erin Boettcher, Kassie Thompson and Amy Miller were part of the All-Conference Team. **Girls Track**
